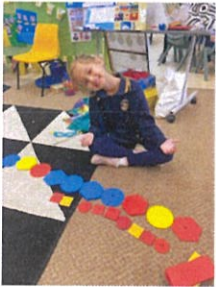
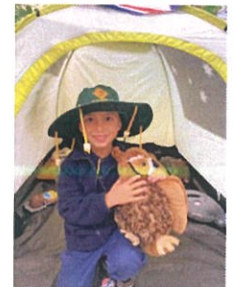


Pre-Primary

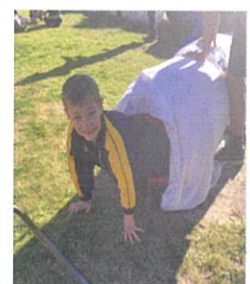


Year 1
