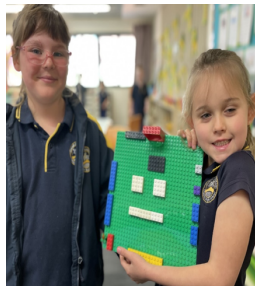

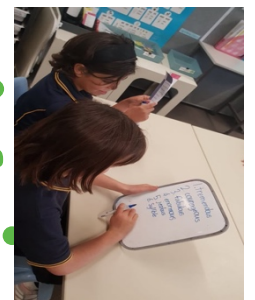


Room 26...
